## Lourdes Pilgrimage 2018

This year marks the 160th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady to Bernadette in Lourdes. The Diocesan Pilgrimage begins on 26th July when over 750 pilgrims will begin their journey to the shrine. The Intentions for this year's Pilgrimage (which you might like to pray for at your Sunday Masses on 29th July) are:

- For the renewal of true faith and for ever deepening love for the Holy Eucharist in all of our hearts;
- For new and generous vocations to the Priesthood, the Consecrated Life and to Christian Marriage;
- For the Diocesan Youth Mission,
- For Caritas Diocese of Shrewsbury in the service of the family and the poorest, and for the support and renewal of parish catechesis in passing on the fullness of faith to new generations;
- For western societies where the Culture of Death in abortion increasingly prevails, that the Gospel of Life shining out in the message of Lourdes may lead to the conversion of hearts and minds.
